Coach and Instructor Development

The Georgian Nordic Ski Club recognizes the importance of having qualified coaches and instructors available to support the development of Nordic skiers at all levels.

To facilitate the development of coaching expertise the Club will provide funds to subsidize the participation of club members in acquiring coaching and instructional certification through courses provided by nationally and provincially recognized Cross Country Ski organizations.

Funds provided will be directed to offset a portion of the costs associated with registration in certification courses.

The Club shall determine from year to year an amount that will be allocated to certification of coaches and instructors. The allocated funds will be placed on a budget line identified as Skier Development

Individuals interested in using available funds will be directed to contact the Board member who is the leader of the Jack Rabbit program and/or the Director with responsibilities for Skier Development.

The leader of the Jack Rabbit Program and the Director designated by the Board will jointly determine the individuals who will receive an incentive and will keep the Board informed of decisions made in this regard. Without prior approval of the board subsidies are not to exceed 50% of the registration costs for certification courses. Major criteria for selection will include a demonstrated commitment to coaching and instruction in the context of Club activities, events and programs.
